The motion to dismiss is GRANTED to the extent that this appeal is DISMISSED based on appellant’s egregious failure to pursue the appeal in conformity with the court rules where his appellant’s brief includes citation to two non-existent cases. MCR 1.109(E)(5)(b); MCR 7.211(C)(2)(b). However, appellees’ request for sanctions in the present motion is not properly presented. See MCR 7.211(C)(8) (directing that request for sanctions for vexatious proceedings should be made in a motion filed “within 21 days after the date of the order or opinion that disposes of the matter that is asserted to have been vexatious”). This order is without prejudice to appellees filing a motion for sanctions for vexatious proceedings within 21 days after the date of this order.
